Epilepsy Resources Table

Several professional groups are committed to offering educational resources for the care of people with epilepsy. These resources are generally publicized and available only to members of that group.

As part of the Veterans Affairs Epilepsy Centers of Excellence (ECoE) which was formed by an act of Congress in 2009, the ECoE Nursing Workgroup developed its own educational resources and programs for nurses. We soon realized that many programs already existed. So to avoid duplicating resources members of this group joined with representatives from the Epilepsy Special Focus Group of the American Association of Neuroscience Nurses and the Interprofessional Education Committee of the American Epilepsy Society to develop a table of educational resources in epilepsy. The result of that effort is presented in the following tables.
